Bread of Life Food Pantry Welcomes Clients at St. John Lutheran

The Bread of Life Food Pantry operates on the 2nd and 4th Mondays of each month from 1-3 p.m. from the basement of St. John Lutheran Church at 5977 Lower Tug Fork Road in Camp Springs. Covid-era curbside service is no longer provided. Patrons who meet USDA income regulations, which are available at <https://www.nkadd.org/commodities-program/> are eligible to receive USDA-provided foodstuffs once a month. In addition to the boxes of food packed according to USDA guidelines, patrons are welcomed to the Selection Room where they can choose a stipulated number of items as they would in a supermarket. The items in the Selection Room are provided free of charge, and are donated by area schools, churches and individuals or purchased by the food pantry from monetary donations. The pantry is staffed and run by volunteers from St. John and St. Luke Lutheran churches and other community members. *For more information, please stop by the Bread of Life Food Pantry during open hours and speak with the volunteers.*
